

Extended Respite Service



Information for clients

Respite Support when your family need it.

Respite Support is a service that gives your carers or family members the chance to take a break to rest and recharge.

Our care team provides temporary care for you, so they can take a planned break to relax, attend appointments or do something they enjoy.

Extended Respite Service

Our Extended Respite Service provides even greater flexibility.

Usually respite services are a few hours in duration. Extended Respite is available for longer times including evenings so your carer can attend an event or celebration without having to rush home.

How it works

Your Care Coordinator will discuss your needs and develop a quote.

- We will develop a care plan that suits you and a Care Aide will come to your home to help you manage while your carer is away.
- Your Care Aide can assist with minor household tasks whilst they are with you but are not there to do extensive cleaning or gardening. Their primary focus is supporting you and providing companionship.
- Your Care Aide will require access to your kitchen and a place they can take a scheduled break during their shift. You will also need to have mobile phone network coverage in your home.

Availability



Services are available in metro and some regional areas in WA. Contact us on **1300 650 803** to see what is available in your area.

Eligibility and cost



If you are 65 years and over or are of Aboriginal Torres Strait Islander descent and are over 50 years, you may be eligible for Government Aged Care

Funding for these services.

If you already have Government Aged Care Funding you can use this to pay for all, or most of the services you need. You may need to pay a co-contribution based on your circumstances and funding.

Services are also available on a fee for service basis (private funding).
